In 2016, the École nationale supérieure d'architecture de Nantes opened an international campus in Mauritius. At the crossroads of three continents (Africa, Asia, Oceania), this island, located in the Indian Ocean, hosts a great ambition for the training of tomorrow's architects. With teaching skills from all corners of the globe, this ambition is driven by the global emergency of the "New Climate Regime". ensa Nantes [Mauritius] is both a school and a laboratory. A school for innovative teaching practices. A laboratory for innovation in scientific production. It is an international campus dedicated to architectural quality; a place of higher learning that promotes a culture of transformation to accelerate the ecological and solidarity-based shift.

ensa Nantes [Mauritius] is officially recognized by the French and Mauritian authorities. It trains students for the following two degrees: Bachelor of Architecture & Urbanism and Master of Architecture & Urbanism.

Under the authority of the Board of Directors, the Director of ensa Nantes [Mauritius] is responsible for the general running of the campus. Within the framework of the charter governing relations between ensa Nantes and its campus in Mauritius, he/she contributes to the harmonisation of the two sites. In the day-to-day life of the campus, he/she is responsible for organizing the work of the school's governing bodies, preparing evaluation and accreditation files, implementing institutional partnerships, promoting international openness and mobility, developing the various forms of training on offer, implementing a research policy, and managing budgetary and human resources. In general terms, the Director of ensa Nantes [Mauritius] brings together all the elements required to ensure the influence and attractiveness of this international campus.

The Director of ensa Nantes [Mauritius] has an architectural background, experience of the challenges of training architects, knowledge of spatial planning policies, experience of institutions, and knowledge of international exchanges and partnerships.
